

Overview

The CMIO for Renown Health stands on the disruptive boundary where technology meets patient safety and quality, patient and provider engagement, and cost-effective care. This CMIO will harness the power of technology to lead healthcare delivery into the future.

This individual will closely align with Renown leadership and will partner with physician leadership to ensure the successful adoption of technology.

Renown Health continues to expand in rural health, receiving a Hemsley Grant to provide patient management for thirteen critical access hospitals in the region.

This position is not only about overseeing the Epic EHR, but also an opportunity to join Renown, build relationships, and lead a successful informatics program

Renown Health will be launching two innovative programs:

- 1) Home for Dinner: Each specialty will have a part-time CMIO to collaborate with physicians in their specialties to find shortcuts, smart sets, and other areas to help physicians be more effective and reduce burnout.
- 2) Ambulatory SWAT team: Each site will have a survey about 4 weeks before an on-site to find out issues so the informatics team can work with clinic and strive to resolve 80% of their issues in a week and up to 95% within a month. With multiple teams, they plan to cover each ambulatory practice within 10 months and then start over.

To be successful with these programs, the CMIO will need to build and oversee physicians from each specialty.

- In conjunction with others, develop “clinical” rules to support patient care.
- Lead the design of clinical pathway models.
- Lead cultural change in the clinical community.
- Serve as a member of the IT steering committee.
- Chair the clinical/physician steering committees.
- Lead efforts to develop clinical data sources for reporting and analysis that support improved clinical quality and efficiency.

Reno is located about 15 miles from the California border in the southern part of Washoe County, nestled on the eastern slope of the Sierra Nevada Mountains in an area called the Truckee Meadows.

The Reno-Tahoe region offers four seasons of outdoor recreational opportunities. Reno's downtown centerpiece, The Truckee River has a beautiful kayaking and tubing park anchoring the Riverwalk District. Pyramid Lake is a great western spot for water skiing.

Lake Tahoe, the largest alpine lake in Northern America is only 45 minutes away by car. Lake Tahoe is surrounded by the peaks of the Sierra Nevada and acres of national forest. Activities to do there include mountain biking, hiking, river rafting, and camping. Sand Harbor Beach has some of the Lake's clearest waters and hot spots for underwater crawdad catching. The Flume Trail is a 14-mile mountain bike trail that provides scenic Tahoe views at 8,000 ft above sea-level. There are top-rated ski resorts including Mt. Rose which boasts the highest base elevation of Reno Tahoe's ski resorts and hosts cookouts, live music, costume parties, and fun-themed ski races.

Reno also hosts the Great Reno Balloon Race, the largest free hot air ballooning event in the world.
